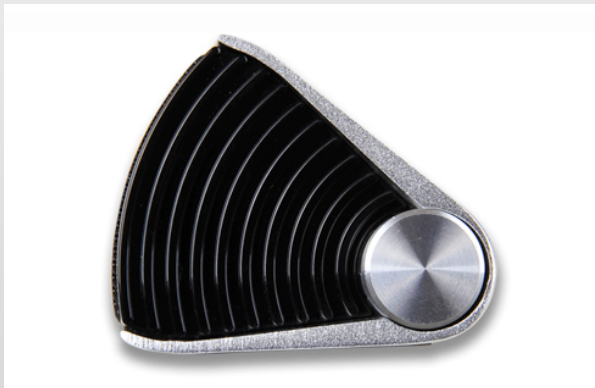

This Speaks to Us: The Edifier Sound To Go

Sure, thumping bass and 11-point surround sound have their place, but when it comes to your home computer, sometimes you just want to hear what the hell that dude is saying to his cat on YouTube. For its size, the Edifier Sound To Go delivers a shocking amount of volume and clarity in a sleek brushed aluminum chassis. It's small enough (less than 11" long and under a pound) to slide easily into a carry-on, but the sound it produces earns it a place on your desktop, too.



Many computer speakers look amazing in the store but end up creating a rat's nest of wires when you set them up at home. From a computer, the Sound to Go requires just a single USB cable, with no drivers required for PC or Mac, and also works with portable audio sources (power it using any charger with a mini-USB tip—like the one that came with your BlackBerry—and hook it up to the headphone jack of your iPod).

Best of all, the monolithic de-

sign looks cleaner than even the fanciest pair of satellites. Don't expect miracles in the bass department (you're listening to four speakers and a woofer—none more than an inch and a quarter high), but if you're willing to sacrifice some low end for pristine mids and highs, this is \$50 well spent.
