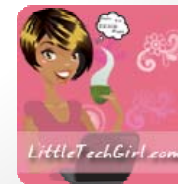

If you are tired of the tinny sounds from your laptop then something like this product is a good solution. This is the 'Edifier USB Soundbar'... As with other Edifier products it comes well packaged, in a nice black soft touch pouch which is great to keep it in should you carry it around with you to places like friends houses... Setup is very easy and everything you need is supplied. To use on your laptop/PC you simply plug it into a USB port, this box will soon appear and you are ready to go. Alternatively you also have an AUX input should you wish to use it on your iPod/MP3 player... The top end of the device has a very smart blue light to let you know it is working. For this review, I was using my MacBook Pro to test the Edifier Sound To Go – a compact unit housing a row of speakers and made to plug into a desktop or portable computer via USB – when I had a 'Eureka!' moment. Why not try connecting it to the iPad using Apple's handy iPad Camera Connection Kit? It was a long shot, as the iPad doesn't produce enough power to pass on to most USB peripherals, but I plugged the Sound To Go's USB cable into the small, white Apple adaptor, and plugged that into the iPad. ...It's an effective upgrade for the sound from my vintage Thinkpad. First off, Sound To Go is louder. I've often resorted to headphones to hear audio clearly from the Thinkpad. That's not necessary with Sound To Go in place. Another benefit is the improved stereo image which tremendously enhances both music listening and movie

watching. And Sound To Go tucks into the hinge area quite discreetly, doesn't get in the way of the screen or keyboard, and doesn't call attention to itself visually. Sound To Go's volume control exemplifies the restrained and elegant visual impression. It's tucked neatly into the right end of the unit and is flush with the shape defining aluminum frame. It's so neatly tucked, that turning it to adjust the sound level could be very inconvenient. The slick design trick here is that it's not a knob so you're not called upon to turn it. It's a button. Successive presses increase the volume. Holding it down continuously decreases the volume. Intuitive? No. Easy, convenient, and elegant? Yes.

...So what we have here is not only an excellent audio enhancing accessory for laptop computer users, but also a compact, easy to use device for turning a personal media player into a social media player. And we all know the importance of social media these days.

It looks nice – all silver and smooth, not a fugly blob of black plastic. Overall: It would make an excellent gift for a techie who works regularly with a laptop or ipod/iphone on the road...I didn't want a Soundbar until I tested it, and now I am very glad to have it. It is darn small, and reasonably light.

No setup required (plug in, pause for recognition, then it worked straight away – fark!). Comes with a nice handy carry sleeve, so that it won't get wrecked by your other gear. Far better sound quality than standard laptop speakers.

"Hey I wanna have that," were the first words that came out of Tyson, our videographer, when he first saw the Edifier MP250 Soundbar multimedia speaker. His next words were: "What is that anyway?" True enough there's something in the brushed aluminum and matt black finish and the proportions of the Soundbar that make people seem to want to get there hands on it – even before they know what it's for. There's more than just good looks going for the MP250 though. When connected to a laptop via its USB cord, the product ...is able to pump up the volume those tiny, squeaky onboard speakers on your computer.
